



CREATION FEST JOB DESCRIPTIONS

SETUP

This is an important role to help prepare the site from the start of the Festival. Set-up will be on **Friday 6 August** from 8am – 10pm. If you are a practical person, able to use Construction and DIY tools this could be the role for you.

TEARDOWN

Tear down requires similar skills to set-up. Helping to take everything down and put it back to its rightful place or owner is a huge task and as the saying goes 'many hands makes light work'. Tear down will be on **Saturday 14 August**.

PRAYER TEAM

This Festival would not be running if it weren't for people lifting it up in prayer. We need a large number of volunteers who are excited about prayer to spend time in prayer for the Festival. Prayer cover will be throughout out the event.

CHILDREN'S WORK

This role requires you to work alongside children and appropriately encourage them, play with them and pray with them. The children's groups include ages from 0 to 12 years. You will be involved with helping with drama, crafts, games, bible studies, etc. If you already help out in Sunday school at your home church you will enjoy this role.

YOUTH (Must be 18+)

New for 2010, Creation Fest will be hosting activities and Worship Services for the youth. If you are a youth worker, or have experience working with youth, this could be the role for you.

SPORTS

This role is for the "sporty" people among you who love to play football, volleyball, basketball, etc. You will be required to help set up and supervise whilst games are being played.

SKATE / BMX PARK

This is where all the action is! If you are a keen skater / BMX'er and would like to steward the park, maintaining its safety whilst it's being skated, then this is for you. Even those without skate / BMX experience can still apply!

INFORMATION

This is a very important role as you will be the first people to come into contact with the visitors on site. A warm friendly nature and a willingness to help our visitors with any questions they might have is essential. Local knowledge is desirable.

CATERING

A Food and Hygiene Certificate is essential for most catering roles, please include a copy if you have one. The role of catering volunteers is varied and may include any of the following:

- Working behind a counter serving teas, coffees, snacks, etc.
- Handling money - so experience with tills is desirable.
- Cooking and/or preparing meals throughout the day for Crew and Artists.
- Stocking supplies such as snacks, milk, sugar, etc.
- Clearing and wiping tables, general catering cleaning and picking up associated litter.
- Making people feel welcomed and 'at home' whatever catering role you are serving in.

If you have worked in a commercial kitchen before and enjoyed it, please apply.

LITTER TEAM

This very important role is to help keep the Creation Fest site in a high standard of health and hygiene by picking up litter, emptying bins and making sure the site looks clean and tidy.

MAINTENANCE

This responsible role will involve making sure the festival runs smoothly and effectively. This is a practical role and will be suited to you if you are gifted in the areas of carpentry, plumbing, electrics and general maintenance jobs.

CLEANING

This role is about keeping the site clean and tidy, which involves keeping the toilets and showers clean and topped up with toilet paper, general cleaning and collecting any rubbish you see on site.

CAMPSITE

You could be the first face someone sees as they book into the Creation Fest campsite site so a warm smile and friendly nature, and willingness to help is essential as you book in campers, show them to their pitch and help them with any questions they might have.

STEWARD (Must Be 18+)

A Steward covers a range of roles and is required throughout the event. A steward will be expected to help implement Creation Fest site rules and to help visitors attending the event to enjoy their time safely.

PARKING (Must be 18+)

This is an important role where you will be required to direct traffic as it comes on and off the site. We need to park cars in a precise manner to ensure the safety of pedestrians and campers as well as making the best use of our car parking space.

TEAM LEADERS (Must be 18+)

This is an important and responsible role as each Ministry needs a team leader to oversee their volunteers and maintain smooth running of the teams duties. They will also need to report to a zone manager and attend meetings as and when required.

RETAIL

This involves selling Artist / Exhibition merchandise; so a friendly face and experience of handling money is desirable.
