Pop-Up Passage

This week's memory verse is Isaiah 61:1&2 (see below).

- 1. Give each member of the family a phrase or two to memorise from the words below.
- 2. Film each one 'popping up' from a surprising or unexpected location, saying their phrase.
- 3. Edit them all together. Make it an epic movie with backing tracks etc, if you have the skills!
- 4. Have fun.
- 5. Share with another family and get them to do one for you!

"The Spirit of the Sovereign Lord is on me, because the Lord has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor.

He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim freedom for the captives and release from darkness for the prisoners, to proclaim the year of the Lord's favour and the day of vengeance of our God."

Pass It On!

Step 1: One family member writes down a fun saying or sentence - the sillier the better.

e.g. "I love to ride my tortoise through the middle of town on Tuesday with my friends."

Step 2: The first family member shows this to the next family member (without anyone else seeing). The second family member now has to draw this silly saying, using no words or symbols. No one else should see the drawing.

Step 3: The second person shows the drawing to the third family member who has to whisper it to the fourth family member.

Step 4: The fourth family member writes down what they've heard and then announces the saying aloud to everyone.

Step 5: Everyone laughs at the hilarity of what has happened!

(If you have more or less family members you can remove a step or add steps in

- this could include having them attempt to say the saying to the next person

without opening their lips, or even using a different language if that is a skill you posses in your family).

Raising the Joy Level

Here is some inspiration to help you bring God's Kingdom near, while out and about with your family...

Flowers

Buy some bunches of flowers. Go down the High Street, popping into each shop and giving a flower to each of the Shop keepers/ cashiers. Thank them for the way they serve the community.

Or, you could pick a different set of recipients: Police officers, supermarket staff, council workers etc.



Chocolates

Buy a box of Celebrations, Heroes or similar chocs. If you have time, you could also buy gift tags.

Ask God for messages of encouragement and hope, to write on the tags, and tie each to a chocolate. Then ask God who to give them to, and do it.

If you don't have time to write tags, just ask God who to bless with a chocolate, and maybe a say something encouraging when you give it.



Generosity

Tape pound coins to different vending machines with a little note saying "Enjoy a treat" or "Enjoy this random act of kindness".

Alternatively, stick coins to small cards saying something like "Surprise! Have a treat on us"... leave them in places they can be discovered eg benches, coffee shop tables, kids' rides etc.



You will need some plain card and coloured pencils/ felt tips, or, if you are in a hurry, a pack of "blank for your own message" cards. Children's home-made cards always bring a smile, so get them involved! Ask God what the picture on the front should be, and if that means anything for the person who will receive it. Ask Him for scriptures, encouragements or words to write inside (maybe explaining the picture, but not necessarily).

Look out for the people God wants you to give the cards to.

You could do this in a café or coffee shop, or at the park.

Hidden messages

Depending on how much time you have, you will need either sticky notes and pens, or smooth stones and paint or sharpies.

Write messages of encouragement and hope on the sticky notes, eg "To whoever gets this note: smile, because you are wonderful!" or "Your life has a purpose – the world is better because you are in it!" You could stick them inside cubicles in public toilets, on supermarket shelves, amongst books in the library – have fun! The same principles apply for messages

on stones, just make them pretty and hide them in public outdoorsy places: flower beds, parks, beside paths etc.
