NEW MESSAGE

Host:

One thing is absolutely clear right now, the world is hurting. The tensions, conflicts, pain, fear, and anxieties are on a level that is beyond anything we've seen before. Yet even through all of this, our faith in the life, death, and resurrection of the Lord Jesus Christ is the game changer.

Question:

What do you think of the lesson Jesus is teaching in Matthew 7:24-27?

Host:

If we build our lives on a pension plan, holiday home, career, or on the apparent success the world offers, we realise we're building our lives on shifting sand. As soon as the storms come, the sand shifts, and our lives collapse.

What was once certain is not certain anymore. We are heading into a time of chaos. But if our lives, hope, and trust is on the Rock, Jesus Christ, no matter what happens we'll stand firm and survive the storm.

Question:

Read what Jesus says about Himself in John 6:35. What is He declaring to you?

Host:

In the lives of all men and women there is an itch that cannot be scratched ... a sense of hunger and thirst ... that the things of this world will never satisfy.

Deep down we all know the kind of men and women we want to be. Self-help books, fitness, golf, money in the bank isn't going to get us there. The Bible says the only thing that is going to satisfy is to put our faith, hope, life, and trust in the Lord Jesus Christ.

Question:

How do you see 2 Corinthians 5:17 lived out in the criminal and the police officer?

Host:

At the Gathering [a festival for guys] a cheerful, shell-shocked criminal gave his life to Christ. All his life he hated the police, but that night he realized he loved the police, and wanted to give a policeman a hug. The next night Carl invited any Christian policemen to come forward and give this mate a hug. Thirty policemen ran to the center of the big top. They hugged, kissed, and wouldn't let go of each other. One officer, suffering from PTSD and couldn't sleep because of the trauma, said that after that hug, he's been sleeping like a baby. Only the Gospel of Jesus Christ can do that! In an age where there is division, enmity, fear, anxiety, and tribalism how much more do we need the Gospel?

Question:

What is promised in Romans 1:16? Write down a name or names you are praying experience the fulfilment of the promise in Romans 1:16.

Host:

If you are a follower of Jesus, share this precious and beautiful Good News to the hungry and thirsty souls living in our increasingly confused world. Only the Gospel of Jesus Christ will change the world. And God uses us. When we step out, we will see the extraordinary power of God that transforms lives.

If you don't know Jesus, only He can scratch the itch. Only He can satisfy the deep longing of your soul. The Bible says that Jesus died for you on a cross. All the pain, mess, and death you've heaped upon yourself and on others, Jesus dealt with by dying on the cross. The Bible says that after three days Jesus rose again to show that the stuff that brings death into our lives has been defeated. We can now live a new life in Christ.
